Councilman Stevie Grice called the meeting to order and presided over the meeting.

Councilman Dennis Townsend gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Councilman Stevie Grice begin the meeting by asking council to amend the agenda by adding item number 17 to the agenda which was to recognize February 2024 as Black History Month and the adoption of the Proclamation for Black History Month and to move the other items down.
